Campus Overview

- The campus opened in May 2022.
- The 107,000-square-foot training facility has 11 classrooms, 6 classroom/labs and 7 individual laboratories.

Core Programs

The Automotive Technology program teaches students how to diagnose, maintain and repair domestic and foreign automobiles.

The Diesel Technology program teaches students the basic knowledge and skills to diagnose malfunctions in mechanical and electrical systems and make necessary repairs and replacements on diesel engines, commercial vehicles, and heavy.

The Automotive and Diesel Technology program combined program provides students with every Automotive and Diesel course, providing graduates the flexibility to pursue careers in both industries.

The Welding Technology program gives the hands-on training needed to prepare for a flexible career in industries from automotive fabrication to aerospace. Students learn about the procedures and equipment required to weld using gas metal arc (GMAW), shielded metal arc (SMAW), flux-cored arc (FCAW) and gas tungsten arc (GTAW) welders.

[The HVACR Technician program](#) is a 9-month program that provides students with the knowledge and skills necessary to install, troubleshoot, maintain, and repair both residential and commercial systems.

Specialized Training

- UTI-Austin provides the training necessary to prepare graduates to pursue careers as entry-level automotive, diesel service, or welding technicians.
- Each student graduates with either a diploma or Associate in Occupational Studies (AOS) degree, depending on the program, with the possibility of additional certifications.
