

FACT SHEET UTI-Avondale, AZ

Campus Overview

- The original campus opened in 1965 and relocated to Avondale in 2004.
- This 283,000-square-foot training facility is in Avondale, AZ., a suburb west of Phoenix.
- Since first opening, the UTI-Avondale campus has prepared more than 50,000 technicians for the transportation industry.

Core Programs

<u>The Automotive Technology II program</u> teaches students how to diagnose, maintain and repair domestic and foreign automobiles.

<u>The Diesel Technology II program</u> teaches students the basic knowledge and skills to diagnose malfunctions in mechanical and electrical systems, and make necessary repairs and replacements on diesel engines, commercial vehicles, and heavy equipment.



<u>The Welding Technology program</u> gives the hands-on training needed to prepare for a flexible career in industries from automotive fabrication to aerospace. Students learn about the procedures and equipment required to weld using gas metal arc (GMAW), shielded metal arc (SMAW), flux-cored arc (FCAW) and gas tungsten arc (GTAW) welders.

<u>The Airframe & Powerplant Technician program</u> – The 18-20 month program covers basic sheetmetal and welding familiarization, assembly and rigging, airframe fire protection, airframe electrical, navigation and communication systems, hydraulics and pneumatics, reciprocating engine operation, and propellers. Graduates are eligible to apply and test for Airframe and Powerplant FAA Certification.

COMING SOON: <u>HVACR Technician program</u> – The 39-week program provides students with the knowledge and skills necessary to install, troubleshoot, maintain, and repair both residential and commercial systems.

Specialized Training

UTI-Avondale provides the training necessary to begin a career as an entry-level automotive or diesel service technician.

Manufacturer-Specific Advanced Training (MSAT)¹

<u>BMW FastTrack</u> – The 12-week BMW FastTrack program will develop knowledge and skills specific to BMW products that will qualify them for opportunities with BMW service departments. Graduates of the BMW FastTrack program are able to earn seven BMW factory credentials and a BMW Associate Level Certification after passing BMW-specific ASE testing and assessments.

<u>GM Technician Career Training</u> - The 12-week program provides a mix of hands-on and online learning to diagnose, repair and maintain gasoline and diesel vehicles for the Chevrolet, Buick, GMC and Cadillac brands. Graduates can earn General Motors course credits toward Bronze, Silver and Gold certification levels in multiple service areas.

<u>Cummins Engines and Cummins Power Generation</u> – The 12-week Engines and 12-week Power Generation programs provide training specific to Cummins diesel engines and power generators.

<u>Daimler Trucks North America Finish First (DTNA)</u> – The 12-week program provide the opportunity to qualify as Expert Level Technicians — Daimler's highest ranking — with certifications to work on Freightliner and Western Star brands.

Ford Accelerated Credential Training (FACT) – The 15-week FACT intensive training program uses Ford Motor Company curriculum, vehicles, components, and diagnostic equipment. Graduates earn up to 10 Ford STST classroom course credentials, the required eLearning credentials toward achieving 9 Ford specialty certification areas, and Ford Quick Lane Technician certification.

<u>Volvo Tekniker Apprentice:</u> – The 12-week program provides the training and qualifications necessary for graduates to seek a career working with Volvo and, ultimately, to pursue their status as a Master Volvo Technician.

STEM, Community & Educator Outreach

UTI-Avondale is the state's largest supplier of blood in the organization category.
- The campus also participates in many events for students and the community, including Student Appreciation Day, car shows, a luncheon for students on the day after Thanksgiving, and Christmas Angel program.
