



FACT SHEET UTI-Bloomfield, NJ

Campus Overview

- The campus opened in August 2018 and graduated its first class in June 2019.
- The 102,000-square-foot training facility is located in Bloomfield, NJ, roughly 18 miles northwest of NYC.
- The key Tri-State area partners that employ UTI graduates are Ray Catena Motor Car, Open Road Auto Group, Penske Automotive Group, Crown Lift, Firestone Complete Auto Care, Lithia, PepBoys (Icahn Automotive Group), FedEx Freight, and Penske Truck Leasing.
- UTI-Bloomfield has several Early Employment Program partners, including: Ciocca Dealerships, Gabrielli Truck Sales, Hudson County Motors, Krehel Automotive Repair, Lithia & Driveway, Penske Automotive, Ray Catena Auto Group, Republic Services, and Sysco.
- UTI-Bloomfield awards the following certificates:

 - Diesel Technology II

 - Welding Technology
- There are approximately 60 employees at the UTI-Bloomfield campus.

Specialized Training

UTI-Bloomfield provides the training necessary to prepare graduates to pursue careers as entry-level automotive or diesel service technicians.

Core Programs

Automotive – The program teaches students how to diagnose, maintain and repair domestic and foreign automobiles.

Diesel & Industrial – The program teaches students the basic knowledge and skills to diagnose malfunctions in mechanical and electrical systems and make necessary repairs and replacements on diesel engines, commercial vehicles, and heavy equipment.

Automotive/Diesel & Industrial – The program combines all the courses from the Automotive Technology plus the Diesel & Industrial Program to train students for a career as a professional technician in each of these industries.

Welding – The program teaches students welding theory, principles of welding, gas metal arc welding (GMAW), shielded metal arc welding (SMAW), engineering & fabrication, flux-cored arc welding (FCAW), gas tungsten arc welding (GTAW), pipe welding, and welding applications.

Manufacturer-Specific Advanced Training (MSAT)¹

Ford Accelerated Credential Training (FACT) – The 15-week program teaches students about the equipment and procedures used in Ford and Lincoln service departments around the nation.
